




Galentine's Day for ROH Moms!

The spring fundraiser, this year, is a golf tournament! This fundraiser has the potential to net \$7500!

Now, you might be saying to yourself, "I don't play golf." Or, "I don't know (or care) how a golf tournament works." They are fun for everyone, and there are MANY moving parts. We need Aggie Mom Volunteers to pull off every single one!

When golfers play a charity tournament, like ours, they will be looking for fun golf games/rewards and, boy, have we got 'em! We will have cards (\$20) for purchase that gain them Mulligans (a do over), a Miracle Putt (get on the green and call it good) and eligibility for a Hole-in-One prize (sponsored). Each tee (there are 18) will have a sponsor, with signage. The players will get swag bags with snacks and golf items, lunch by Chick-Fil-A, dinner in the clubhouse....on and on.

If you decide to play, have your significant other meet you for dinner! Players can bring a guest, and volunteers can dine, too! The club will set the price at \$15-20 for extra diners. We will have a cash bar, and a concessions cart touring the course, all afternoon.

Here's a breakdown of what we'll have going on, and where we really need YOU!

Set up signs and markers at each tee box (6 - 8 people)

Outside, 11:00 - 12:30pm

Duties: Take yard signs and set up at each tee box; set out markers for "closest to the pin" and "longest drive holes"

• Set up banners and inside club house set up (3-4 people)

Some inside and outside, 11:00 – 1:00pm

Duties: Set up sponsor banners, registration tables, lunch boxes, grab bag, and t-shirts. After play has started, set up tables for after tournament dinner.

• Inside clubhouse, needed 11:30 - 1:30pm

Registration – 2 - 3 people

Duties: Check-in players, pass out t-shirt and grab bag.

- Pass out lunches 1 person
- Mulligan/MP/hole-in-one ticket (\$20) 1 person

Duties: Collect cash for purchasing contest ticket which will include 1 Mulligan per person, 1 Miracle Putt per person, and Hole-in-one Cash prize

• · 50/50 pot – 1 person

Note: We may need to request an employee from the club to run this event so it is not perceived as a "raffle" from us.

Duties: Collect cash for the 50/50 pot, give tickets that are purchased.

50/50 pot is where you sell tickets for \$XX, half of the money goes to the ticket drawn and the other half goes to the wait staff as a tip. Note: This should not count as a raffle for us since we are not benefiting.

Hole in one watchers (min 4 – 8 people)

Outside during tournament 12:45 – 5pm or conclusion of last group.

Duties: Watch and verify if a hole-in-one is made. We will have two of these holes with 2-4 people at each hole.
