

Standing Rules of Collin County Texas A&M University Mothers' Club

1. Scholarships

Nondiscriminatory Policy: Scholarships awarded by the Club shall be restricted to students attending Texas A&M - College Station, Texas A&M – Galveston, or Texas A&M – Qatar, however, such scholarships shall not discriminate on the basis of an individual's age, sex, color, creed and religion or national/ethnic origin.

Scholarship Selection Criteria:

A. New Student Scholarships: The recipient(s) must:

- Meet the following residency requirements:
 - a. Be a graduating senior of a Collin County or a county of a current Collin County Texas A&M University Mothers' Club member attending a public or private senior high school, or
 - b. Be a Collin County resident or a resident of a county of a current Collin County Texas A&M University Mothers' Club member who is a graduating senior of a public or private senior high school in another county, or
 - c. Be a Collin County or a county of a current Collin County Texas A&M University Mothers' Club member home-schooled resident, who meets the entrance requirements for Texas A&M - College Station, Texas A&M – Galveston, or Texas A&M – Qatar for admission as a student.
- Submit the Club's application.
- Attend Texas A&M - College Station, Texas A&M – Galveston, or Texas A&M – Qatar the following fall and spring semester to receive the scholarship financial benefit. The scholarship money will be paid directly to Texas A&M and the school will disburse the funds to the student account in the fall and the spring.

B. Returning Student Scholarships: The recipient(s) must:

- Meet the same residency requirements as the New Student Scholarships or have a declared Home of Record currently in Collin County or a county of a current Collin County Texas A&M University Mothers' Club member
- Have completed at least two semesters at Texas A&M - College Station, Texas A&M – Galveston, or Texas A&M – Qatar. The scholarship funds will be disbursed directly to Texas A&M and the school will disburse the funds to the student account.
- Not have previously received a Collin County Texas A&M University Mothers' Club Scholarship.
- Submit the Club's application.

2. Financial Audit: A Financial Audit will be approved by the Executive Board before being presented to the General membership.

3. Fundraiser Profit:

The Board will vote on the fundraisers and distribution of net profits and this will be reflected in the meeting minutes.
